



The Lord Deighton KBE

Lord Paul Deighton is Chair at Haklyut, Heathrow Airport and The Economist Group

Most recently Lord Deighton was responsible for leading the implementation of the Government's National Infrastructure Plan as the Commercial Secretary to the Treasury (2013 – 2015). He was made a member of the House of Lords in 2012.

From 2006 – 2013, Lord Deighton oversaw the planning and delivery of the London Olympic Games as CEO of LOCOG, the London Organising Committee of the Olympic Games.

His early career was in a variety of banking and capital markets roles with Bank of America (1978 – 1980) and Security Pacific National Bank (1980 – 1983). He then spent 23 years at Goldman Sachs including leading the Transport & Aviation Group (1983 – 1996), heading European operations for Technology & Finance (1996 – 2000) and culminating as European Chief Operating Officer (2000 – 2006).
